Problem Statement:	The Washington Middle School campus has lost many trees. In reviewing the other campuses as well as city parks/green belt areas, there is a need for more trees throughout the city of La Habra. The Rotary Club International is challenging all of its club members to plant one tree for each member. This is a huge undertaking but the La Habra Rotary Club can take the lead.
Design Statement:	The WMS Tree Titans can collaborate with the La Habra Rotary Club and the Arbor Day Foundation. Through this collaboration, ten trees can be planted at each school campus and each city park/greenbelt as well as the school district office.
